In 2006 he was the Senior Fulbright Scholar in Singapore and Indonesia at the Institute of Defence and Strategic Studies at Nanyang Technological University in Singapore. He is also the senior editor of *The Muslim World*. He has published numerous articles, 19 books, and is a research fellow of the Ronning Centre.
