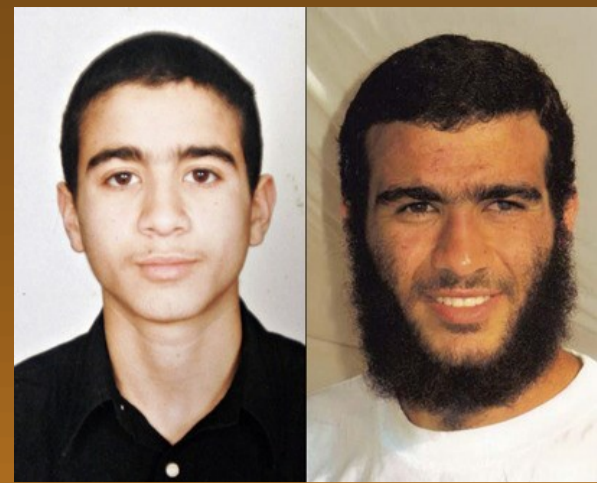


OMAR KHADR:

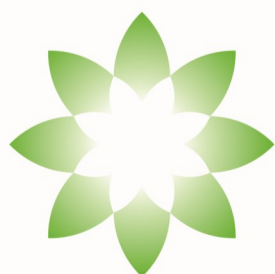
