The Rev. Dr. John Chryssavgis, Archdeacon of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, was born in Australia, completed theology in Athens, and pursued doctoral studies in Oxford. After several months in silent retreat, he co-founded of St Andrew's Theological College in Sydney (1986), where he also taught at the University of Sydney (1985-1995). From 1995 to 2002, he taught theology in Boston. Currently, as an ordained clergyman of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America, where he works in the Office of Ecumenical and Inter-faith Affairs, he serves as theological advisor to the Ecumenical Patriarch on environmental issues. He has written over twenty books on theology, spirituality, and the environment.
